Professional Services Available

Skilled Nursing Services:

- Initial evaluation visit to patients with implementation of clinical plan of care
- Provide services requiring more specialized nursing care, which includes but is not limited to:
 - ✓ Monitor vitals, and measure height and weight
 - ✓ Provide pain management
 - ✓ Perform wound/ostomy care and dressing changes
 - ✓ Prevent pressure ulcers
 - ✓ Prevent and control infections
 - ✓ Diabetic management and care
 - ✓ Orthopedic disorder care
 - ✓ Insulin therapy and IV injection therapy
 - ✓ Left Ventricular Assist Device (LVAD) care
 - ✓ Ventilator and tracheostomy care
 - ✓ Brain and spinal cord injury care
 - ✓ Pharmacy coordination
 - ✓ Coordination of home medical equipment and supplies
 - ✓ Provide patient/family health teachings
 - ✓ Plan for preventative and rehabilitation care

Home Health Aide Services:

- Assist patients with personal care needs
- Periodically check patients' temperature, pulse, and blood pressure
- Maintain daily records to share with families or agency
- Help patients and families adapt to a disability or long-term illness, including, providing emotional support
- Assist patients with getting in and out of bed, wheelchairs, and baths
- Encourage patients to exercise or perform basic physical activities such as walking
- Plan and prepare meals and aid in feeding patients as directed
- Perform light housekeeping and assist with daily chores
- Provide transportation, accompany patients on trips outside the home, to doctor's appointments, and shop for groceries
- Observe and assist patients with taking medications

Physical Therapy Services:

- Evaluation and treatment of patient's rehabilitation needs
- Therapeutic exercises for muscle conditioning and strengthening
- Educate patients/families about home safety

Physical therapy may be applicable for someone experiencing loss of balance; falls, difficult walking, joint pain, and any noticeable decline in function. Or who has experienced hip or knee replacement surgery, stroke, heart failure, or heart attack.

Occupational Therapy Services:

- Training for activities of daily living
- Skills/techniques on adaptive equipment
- Studies, evaluates, and records patients' activities and progress

Occupational therapy may be applicable after a stroke, heart failure, heart attack, hip or Knee replacement surgery.

Speech Therapy Services:

- Swallowing evaluation and treatment
- Language/Communication disorder treatments

Speech therapists may help individuals who suffered/suffer from a stroke, heart attack, difficulty swallowing, or difficulty speaking.

Medical Social Services:

- Assess patients/families' ability to cope with social, psychological, cultural, and medical issues resulting from an illness
- Provide counseling
- Follow up care by referral to community health care resources
